Purpose:

To raise funds for our upcoming trip to Iceland. This trip will broaden the horizons of our students and provide an educational and culturally fulfilling experience. During this trip, students will visit geologically, environmentally, and historically significant sites. The funds raised will cover the costs of tips to drivers and guides as well as transportation to and from the airport. Additional funds will be utilized to cover other expenses incurred for the trip. This event will promote and celebrate the cultural diversity of our community and enhance the cultural awareness of our students. Our goal is to raise approximately \$3,000.

Proposal:

We would like to run a Multicultural Day event, where local businesses and vendors can purchase spots to set up a station for selling their own products, foods, services, or promotions. This event will target vendors who promote a multicultural background for the purposes of exposing the community to the wide range of viewpoints and perspectives inherent to Union. Activities will be planned which will promote diversity, unity, pride within the community, and education about cultures.

The event will take place outside on the grounds of Union High School, with the vendor spots being placed in the practice field. Parking will be provided using the parking lots at Union High School, with the potential for overflow parking at the Rabkin Field parking lot as well as Hannah Caldwell lots. Rabkin Field will also be coordinated to be used for bathrooms, activities, and as a secondary location. In the event of rain, the vendors will be repositioned in the parking lot of Rabkin Field.

Vendors will be charged a fee of \$100 to buy a station. Clubs within the school district will also be allowed to purchase a station for a reduced fee of \$50, while stations will be provided at no cost for each of the graduating classes.

Additionally, we would like only the students who are enrolled in the Iceland trip to be able to purchase a station at a nominal cost of \$10 to fundraise in order to supplement their own costs for the trip.

Some activities we are hoping to include are flags of the world sticker trading, fashion show, cultural dance lessons, and cultural music performances. We will also be organizing a Color Tag using paint powder, similarly used in Color Runs, which will be planned for Rabkin Field. Vendors will be coordinated upon board and town approval of event. We will be charging an admission fee of \$3, with an in-school presale price of \$2. Advertisement will be conducted through district-wide in-school promotion, school and town websites, Facebook, and local businesses. Some organizations will be sought for contribution sponsorships outside of vending to cover entertainment, advertisement, and promotional costs. All non-vendor sales will be organized and supervised by the above stated faculty members and faculty volunteers.
