The CAP program requires a **1½ hour staff in-service** of continuous time for teachers who have not had CAP training in the last three years. The in-service date should be reserved in advance. A **1½ hour parent workshop** is also required for each school; however, where low attendance is anticipated schools, are encouraged to combine these workshops.

Funding may not be authorized to districts who cannot guarantee in-service dates.
